

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES



Mountains, Plains, and Canyons

The Corazón de Trinidad Creative District and the Women's Caucus for Art Colorado Chapter (WCACO) invite women and women-identifying artists from southeastern Colorado and northeastern New Mexico to submit 1-3 works of art that represent this special region. Artists will interpret the broad theme in a personal way so that the exhibition tells a visual story of the richness of women artists and their lives. Exhibition will include murals by seven Colorado women, past and present, who are recognized for significant art contributions.

July 28: Artist Talk at 2:00 pm; Pick up art at 4:00 pm

CREATIVES: Women and women-identifying artists who work and live in southeastern Colorado or northeastern New Mexico.

THEME: We invite women and women-identifying artists to interpret their unique experiences of life in the Mountains, Plains, and Canyons.

MEDIA: A variety of 2D and 3D media will be accepted including crafts, quilting, painting, sculpture, printmaking, drawing, glass, jewelry or any other creative medium.

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- \$25 submission fee
- Submit a minimum of 1 and up to 3 works
- A brief artist statement pertaining to the work submitted and its connection to the exhibit theme.
- 2-D works must be **no larger than 25" x 40."** Accepted work must be WIRED and ready to hang (no saw tooth hangers). Work that is not prepared correctly will not be exhibited.
- 3-D works: Pedestals or necessary display materials must be provided by the artist.

JURY: Gudega Stevens and Abigail Kreuser, owners of Auric Gallery in Colorado Springs.

AWARDS: 1ST PLACE: \$250, 2ND PLACE: \$150, 3RD PLACE: \$100

SALES: Corazon de Trinidad Creative District will make artist contact information available to potential buyers via a QR code on the name plate of each artwork. If an artwork is sold due to participating in this exhibit, the Corazon de Trinidad Creative District will receive a commission of 30% of the sales price. This commission will allow Corazon de Trinidad Creative District to continue creating opportunities for local artists.
